

# SimLa Innovations

Project: **Picture Viewer / Public Service Announcement (PSA)**

Materials: Electronic Picture Viewer.

Cost: \$2.00 - \$5.00 at thrift store or dig out of closet or ask colleagues for unused one

Time: 1 – 2 hours (with a caveat)

Details: Digital picture viewers were all the rage a few years ago. You download your photos and the wall-mounted viewer plugs in and scrolls through your sim-chip photos. To adapt to simulation, convert any information you want students in simlab to know. Create PowerPoint slides that are similar to a hospital's PSA screen saver (handwashing reminders, 'mock' code team extension, patient safety standards, you can even add a 'nurse of the week' to keep their attention lab after lab). Save the PowerPoint slide *as an image*. Upload the images. \*ta-da.\* The 'time' caveat is based on how many images you create and save. Upload all the images and mount the viewer by the simlab nursing station (or simlab entry door). Run the image loop during scenarios (and tours and dignitary walk-throughs).

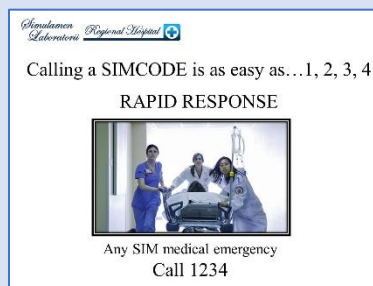
